Some helpful context for House votes:

1. Bill numbers change, often! When legislation is filed it's given a docket number, a bill number, and then that number can change a number of times as it moves through committees on its way to the House floor. That's why you may see some bills with the same title, but different numbers.
2. In the process of how bills become law, they must first be engrossed, before being enacted on a separate vote, that's why you'll see bills listed as being voted on more than once.
3. Amendments can be filed to almost any piece of legislation when it's presented for a vote on the House floor. Most are not dealt with directly on the floor with a voice or roll call vote, but those that have been given a roll call vote this session are listed above, with the outcome for the amendment (whether it was adopted or not in the final legislation) and Rep Domb's vote.
4. Procedurally, the House is required to take a roll call vote in enacting any local land ordinances. For brevity, we've excluded those from this table, but it is Rep Domb's policy to always vote yes on these local bills.
